How to Check out an eBook for Kindle

1. First, you will visit our Great Lakes Digital Libraries site (<http://digitalmedia.gldl.info>) to find an eBook that is available for checkout.
2. When you find an eBook that is available, you will click **Add to Cart** next to Kindle book (not to Adobe EPUB or PDF eBook).
 - a. If you see an eBook with the option Kindle Book and **Add to Cart** it means the title is available for immediate checkout.
 - b. However, if you see Kindle eBook and **Place a Hold**, this book is currently checked out. Feel free to place a hold and our system will alert you to your title is available.

3. After you have selected **Add to Cart** for the proper format, a window with the "My Cart" section will open.
4. Once you're ready, click **Proceed to Checkout**.
5. Choose our library from the drop down menu and sign in with your library card and pin number.
6. Push the **Confirm Checkout** button
7. Click the **Get for Kindle** button
8. You will then be redirected to the Amazon website and a screen with a summary of the eBook you checked out will show up.
9. Once you're ready to sync or download to your Kindle, click the **Get library book** button on the right side of the screen.
10. At this time, Amazon may ask you for your Amazon account information. Please enter the login information you have used to register with Amazon.com before. Your Kindle or Kindle app must also be registered with this login.
11. After you have signed in, you will see the "Deliver To" section. Select which registered Kindle device or app you wish to send your eBook to.
12. Then, click the **Continue** button.
13. If your Kindle is connected to WiFi your eBook will show up on your Kindle homescreen. (Note: 3G connection is not the same as a WiFi connection.)
14. If your Kindle is not connected to WiFi, you can click the **Download now** button.
 - a. When the pop-up menu appears, select **Save**. This will save your Kindle Edition eBook to the default downloads location of your computer.
 - b. To begin reading, first make sure your Kindle is connected to this computer via USB. Then, copy the downloaded file to the "documents" folder of your Kindle. It will appear on your Home screen.
15. Read and enjoy!

Please note: Patrons must have an Amazon account and their Kindle/free Kindle apps must be registered under that account. Setting up an Amazon account is free and only requires an email address. There is no charge to use the books checked out through the Great Lakes Digital Libraries site, but Amazon may recommend books for purchase.
