Mango Languages is a digital language service available from your library for free! All you need is an internet connection, and Adobe Flash Player. The site will prompt you if your Flash is in need of an update, which is a free download. Follow these easy steps to get started!

Step 1: Get Started

Visit the Dickinson County Library homepage, www.dcl-lib.org. Click the Mango button located on the top right side.

Step 2: Create an Account

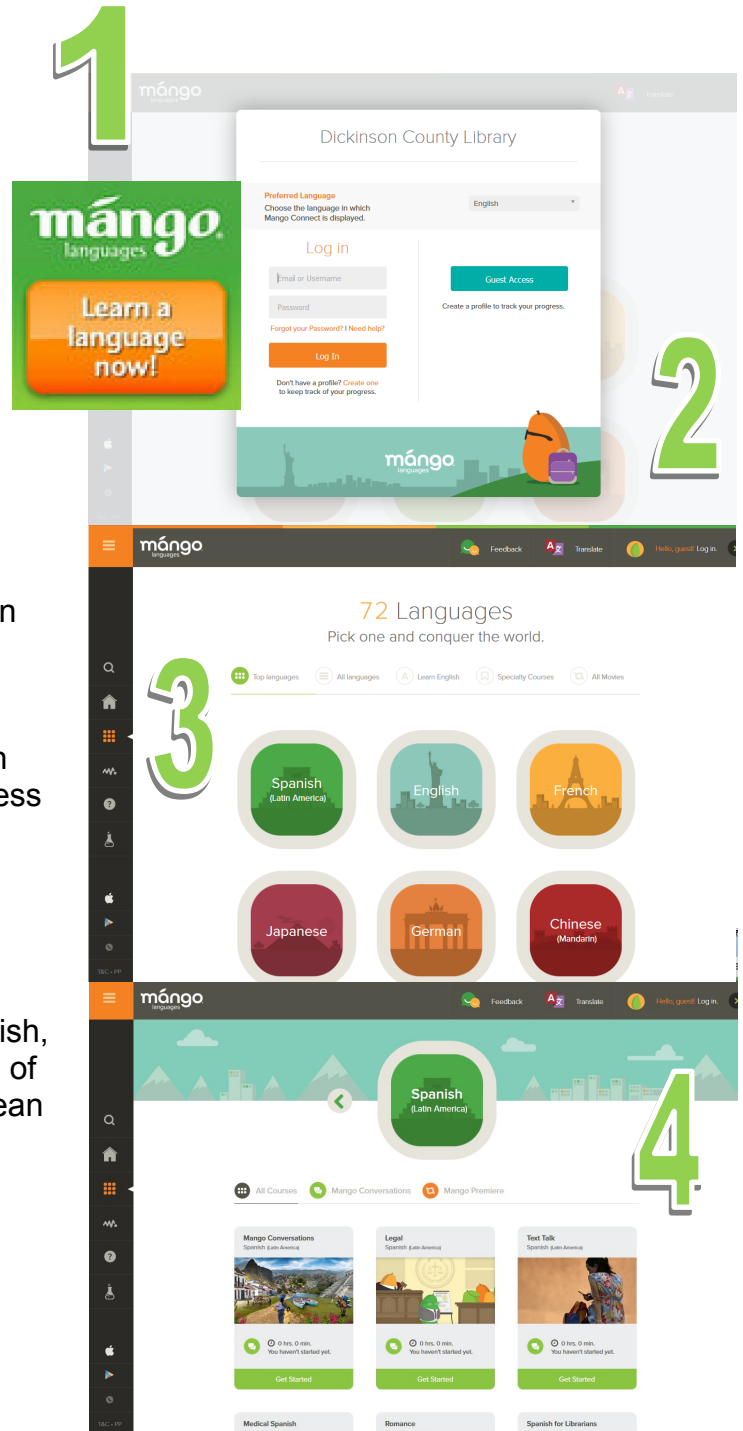
The Mango Connect screen will appear, with Dickinson County Library indicated at the top. Enter in your e-mail address or a username, and a password, to complete account setup. Once your account has been created, you can save your progress in each Language's lessons. You can also choose Guest Access if you do not wish to save your progress.

Step 3: Choose a Language

Browse through 70+ languages, each with lessons, practice, and movies. Popular languages include English, Spanish, and German, but you can also explore some of the more obscure options like Pirate and Shakespearean English!

Step 4: Begin Learning!

If you click on a Language, you will see lessons available to you. Click on a lesson to launch the video and begin learning!
