

WELCOME BACK!



The Main and Solomonson branches are thrilled to announce the move to Phase 5 of the library's Phased Reopening Plan on **Monday, May 17**! Phase 5 means that patrons may enter the building without an appointment, but there will be guidelines in place to ensure the health and safety of patrons AND staff.

These guidelines include:

- Anyone age 2 and older MUST wear a mask that covers their mouth AND nose at all times while
 in the building. If you do not have a mask, disposable masks are available for 25 cents. If you
 are medically unable to wear a mask, staff are happy to assist you through curbside
 service, or you may call BEFORE YOUR VISIT to set up an alternate accommodation.
- Patrons looking for library materials are encouraged to limit their browsing time to 15 minutes or less. For your safety, please touch only the items you intend to checkout.
- A limited number of public computers are available, to allow for social distancing. Computer time is limited to 1 hour per patron per day.
- At Main, seating in the adult reading area has been reduced, the children's room and Local History room will be closed for browsing, and the drinking fountain will not be available.
- Some meeting rooms may be available, but with reduced occupancy limits.

At this time, hours of operation are:

Main & Solomonson Branches: Monday-Friday, 10 AM-6 PM; Saturday, 10 AM-1 PM
North Dickinson Branch: Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday, 10 AM-3:30 PM
The North Dickinson Branch will remain in Phase 4 (appointments only),
due to restrictions from the North Dickinson County School.

Curbside services will continue for interested patrons at both the Main and Solomonson branches on **Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays** from **1-6 PM**, and **Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays** from **10 AM-1 PM**. Please call your local branch for more information or to schedule your appointment time.

PLEASE NOTE:

The library continues to operate under its Phased Reopening Plan, which includes monitoring COVID-19 case numbers in Dickinson County. **Average new case growth must remain at or below .7% or active cases must remain at or below 18% of the total number of cases for the branches to move to and remain in Phase 5.** If not, the branches may revert to Phase 4.
